The Garden of Remembrance at both Bournemouth and Poole features an Octagon planter, onto which black or red (Poole only) granite memorial plaques with a choice of inscription can be placed. The planter is installed and maintained by the Council, and the memorial plaques may be ordered through the Council only.

The Terms and Conditions that apply are:-

- 1. The scheme is reserved for cremations that have taken place, or where ashes have been scattered at the Bournemouth Crematorium or Poole Crematorium.
- 2. The initial contract is for five years from the date of placing the memorial plaque on the Octagon Planter with an option to renew for a further five years at the conclusion of the initial contract.
- 3. At the conclusion of the contract the plaque will be removed and retained for 3 months in the Crematorium office, from where it can be collected if required.
- 4. The wording on the plaque is restricted to a maximum of 3 lines. Please note the maximum number of characters per line as indicated on the Application Form. Spaces and punctuation marks count as a character. Examples of layouts for the inscriptions are given overleaf. Please note that the engraver will centre the inscription on the plaque.
- 5. The Council reserves the right to vary or abbreviate, where necessary, any inscription submitted which is too lengthy to be inscribed on the space provided on the plaque.

The Council also reserves the right to refuse any entry that is considered unsuitable.

- 6. The fee for an initial five-year contract is shown in our current price list.
- 7. The memorial plaque, once placed on the Octagon Planter, becomes the property and responsibility of the applicant. The Octagon Planter is the property and responsibility of the Council, and must not be tampered with in any way.
- 8. The Council will not be liable for the theft or damage to any memorial plaque once it has been placed on the Octagon Planter.
- 9. A small posy vase is provided with each memorial plaque. The vases must only be placed in the holes in the base of the planter, and no other vases, pot plants or any other form of tribute must be placed in, on or around the Octagon Planter. Please respect other plaque owners and do not leave any flowers in the posy vase that unreasonably restrict viewing of the plaques. The Council reserves the right to remove any flowers, plants, tributes etc. as they see fit.
- 10. Applicants may choose the position of the plaque on the Octagon Planter (subject to the position being available). If no preference is stated, the Council will allocate a position in strict order of date of application.
- 11. Applicants will be notified once a plaque has been positioned on the Octagon Planter.
